Background: The WeTHRIVE! Learning Collaborative is an improvement collaborative created to help primary care practices test and implement strategies for improving pediatric obesity screening, assessment and management. Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center and Hamilton County Public Health are collaborating on this project.

The aim of this collaborative is to help primary care practices establish systems to ensure that every child receives proper preventive care, evaluation, and treatment for pediatric obesity, and that each child is linked with needed community resources.
